## Back to Life: Walking in Faith

Hello, parents and students!

Below is a section of scripture to read and discuss with your students, as well as some application questions. I encourage each of you to take your time going through these, and adding questions as you see fit! Please be open and honest while answering the questions *alongside* your students. There is also an activity you can do with your students as well, in order to help them focus on the topic!

**ACTIVITY:** Take a few minutes and write down rules in your house that are important. This could deal with behavior, screen time, chores, etc. Parents, please help your student(s) with this task.

### APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

1. In this passage, the writer lays out a clear message for how to follow Jesus and live out His teachings. What are some ways the writer says this? Discuss this with your student(s).
2. In the passage, it can be seen that it is important for us to pray. Why do you think this is? What should we be praying about?
3. The writer also states that we should have an intense love for one another, and that we should show hospitality to everyone. What does this mean? Give an example of this in your life.
4. The passage also states that we must serve others so that we may glorify Christ. How are you serving your family? Your classmates? Your friends? Your church?
5. We can clearly see in scripture that Jesus will return to earth for a final judgement of our sins, and that this is the context provided for the passage in 1 Peter 4. How does it make you feel that Jesus is coming back? If he came back today, what would he catch you doing? Would you be living for Him?
6. What is one step that you can take this week to walk obediently in faith and live like Jesus will return tomorrow?

**CLOSING ACTIVITY:** Take a few minutes with your student(s) to write down a list of things you would want Jesus to see you doing if he came back to earth tomorrow. Discuss the following: am I doing these things now? If not, what is stopping me?

**HOMEWORK:** Pick one thing on your list from the closing activity. This week, with your student(s), make it your goal to accomplish/grow in this task or action. Discuss the benefits of this step as the week progresses. What has God shown you? How have you grown?
